

# AMEB Exams Music Theory

#### **SYLLABI**

- **Theory of Music** this is the traditional, written theory curriculum offered by AMEB. It focuses on note reading, keys, scales, transposition and musical terms. For higher practical grades, a minimum theory qualification is required. Generally, these exams go hand in hand with the practical courses.
- **Musicianship** the same program as Theory of Music but Musicianship courses add an aural (listening) component from Grade 4 onwards.
- **Music Craft** this course combines the written and the aural (listening) components together from Grade 1.

#### **LEVELS**

- Theory of Music Grades 1 to 6.
- Musicianship Grades 1 to 6.
- Music Craft Preliminary, Grade 1 to 6

### **COST**

Each examination level requires an entry fee. They begin at around \$80 and increase per graded level.

Each level requires students to purchase a workbook. These now come as an integrated package with an online course, and cost around \$30-\$40.

## **LOCATION**

All exams are now conducted online.

Music Craft Grade 5 & 6 are still conducted as written exams.

#### **TIMING**

As online exams must be supervised, KBE will offer end of term sessions for students to attend and sit their theory exam throughout the year. Online courses and exam enrollments are valid for 12 months. Students can do practice exams online prior to taking their final exam in that time.
